APRA's Professional Reserve Analyst (PRA)

Designation. The Professional Reserve Analyst (PRA) credential is earned through a rigorous process that exceeds other organization's requirements. APRA's PRA members achieve this high standard by demonstrating their knowledge and adherence to APRA Standards. Before becoming a credentialed PRA, each applicant must complete a minimum of 50 site visit Reserve Studies, submit a sample Reserve Study, and possess appropriate field experience or college education. All PRAs are required to take continuing education through the APRA Institute and by attending APRA Symposiums. All PRAs adhere to APRA's stringent ethical standards.
